

Objective of TFA

- ✓ Simplification and harmonization of import/export procedures and forms
- ✓ Development of "Single Window" Paperless, Automated Systems
- ✓ Rapid release of goods (e.g., pre-arrival clearance, authorized traders, posting of security)
- ✓ Use of international standards (e.g., WCO Data Model, UN/EDIFACT, UN Lay-out Key (UNLK), UN/CEFACT and UNe-Docs)

INTERNATIONAL TRADE

 In FY2013, U.S. trade accounted for \$2.4 trillion in imported goods and \$1.6 trillion in exported goods

ACE / ITDS

- Executive Order establishes deadline of December 2016 for implementation
- ACE is the technology enabler through which Single Window processing will be achieved
- Key features to enable Single Window processing have been implemented

PARTNER GOVERNMENT AGENCIES

- 47 Partner Government Agencies
- · Largely paper-based with multiple entry systems
- · Nearly 200 forms required for imports and exports



Quicker data availability for Government better identification of dangerous or prohibited shipments



Automated Agency interactions reduce paper, enable near-real time 7 decision making by Government



Easier for industry to comply with government regulations





National Agricultural Release Program (NARP)

- * Methodology for evaluating high-volume agriculture imports that are low-risk for the introduction of plant pests and plant diseases
- * Commercial shipments of fresh, frozen, processed and semi-processed fruits and vegetables from specific countries may be eligible for NARP

Common Trade Facilitation Barriers

- * Excessive documentation requirements
- * Inefficient border-crossing procedures
- * Transport and transit impediments
- Lack of transparency and predictability
- * Lack of cooperation and coordination
- * Lack of automated processes and scarce use of information technology
- High administrative costs







SPS-plus Aspects of TFA

Provide advance rulings besides tariff classification and origin (TF Art. 3) Inform on detention of goods and facilitate test procedures (TF Art. 5)

Review and publish fees and charges (TF Art. 6)

Allow pre-arrival processing / Publish average release times (TF Art. 7)

Publish wide range of information related to import/export requirements and procedures

(TF Art. 1)

"SPSplus"

Border Agency Cooperation (TF Art. 8)

Freedom of transit: Limit formalities and documentation requirements

(TF Art. 11)

Review and reduce import/export transit formalities

(TF Art. 10)



Examples of SPS-related Obstacles and TFA Remedies

- * (Art. 5) Retesting allowed
- * (Art. 8) Border Agency cooperation



* (Art. 10) – Single Window, e-certs

TFA Final Provisions: Paragraph 6

"nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as diminishing the rights and obligations of Members under the TBT and SPS Agreements."

BUT....

some TFA provisions may be "SPS-plus" or "TBT-plus" adding obligations going beyond SPS & TBT Agreements

SPS and TFA Complement

Release and clearance of goods

Harmonized processes and standards

Consultations and appeals

Opportunities to Reduce Costs and Enhance Health Protection

- Streamline/simplify regulations and procedures
- Implement risk-based approaches (inspections)
- Improve transparency
- Improve coordination between SPS authorities and with Customs
- Include SPS controls in national single windows
- Encourage participation of SPS authorities in national Trade Facilitation Committees, etc.
