Consensus:	<ul> <li>Anna-Mary Schmidt (CFIA) provided the following updates on the revision of the grapevine virus and viroids pest table:</li> <li>The subgroup decided to exclude the viroids from the table because they are widely spread across the world and have no know agronomic impact on grapevines.</li> <li>A more updated table is being developed by US members. This table will be share with the subgroup when completed to provide presence/absence information for each virus species/variants. The subgroup will discuss the updated table in their next video conference on January 19, 2021.</li> <li>The subgroup also provided the language to consider for the criteria used to keep/eliminate the virus species in the table.</li> </ul>
