1. Name of Standard

RSPM No. 24 –Integrated Pest Risk Management Measures for the Importation of Plants for Planting into a NAPPO Member Country

3. Relevant Authority

3.1 Current Authority

- A. Legislative Authority – Yes, Plant Protection Act
- B. Regulatory Authority – Yes, but revisions will be necessary

3.2 Revisions to Authority

Revision to our import regulations will be needed to ensure that imported plants for planting comply with the provisions for the production and phytosanitary conditions outlined in the Standard.

4. Obtaining Authority to Adopt the Standard

No changes to the Plant Protection Act are required.
A revision of the Code of Federal Regulations, 7 CFR 319.37 will be required in the long term.
