



#### Why NAPPO for this Symposium?

1951 - International Plant Protection Convention - IPPC

**1976** - NAPPO

1991 - NAPPO (+ USDA-APHIS-PPQ) — Workshop on International Approaches to Plant Pest Risk Analysis paradigm shift in the application of phytosanitary measures

1994 - Signing of the SPS Agreement of the WTO - international standards to facilitate trade – identified IPPC Secretariat for plant health standard setting

1996 - 8<sup>th</sup> Technical Consultation of RPPOs – Called for revision of the IPPC and establishment of permanent procedure for plant health standard setting

1995 & 1997 - Revision of the Convention

#### Why NAPPO for this Symposium?

- 1995 ISPM 2 and 2003 ISPM 11 –Standards on Pest Risk Analysis
- **2001** NAPPO RSPM 11 on Import requirements for wood dunnage ... **2002** ISPM 15 Regulation of wood packaging material in international trade
- **2005** ISPM 23 Guidelines for Inspection connects PRA with inspection
- 2008 ISPM 31 Methodologies for sampling of consignments– hypergeometric based sampling
  - 2017 NAPPO (+ USDA-APHIS-PPQ) International
    Symposium for Risk-Based Sampling paradigm shift in
    the application of risk-based inspection and better
    implementation of ISPMs 23 and 31
